## Time

$$
\begin{gathered}
1 \text { year }=365 \text { days } \\
1 \text { leap year }=366 \text { days } \\
1 \text { day }=24 \text { hours } \\
1 \text { hour }=60 \text { minutes } \\
1 \text { minute }=60 \text { seconds }
\end{gathered}
$$

Time can be written in 12 hour or 24 hour notation.

## Remember:

- In 12 hour notation we must use a.m. or p.m.
- a.m. means 'before 12 noon'
- p.m. means 'after 12 noon'
- In 24 hour notation we must use 4 digits
- We do not use a.m or p.m with 24 hour notation


## Examples:

9.25 in the morning $=9.25$ a.m $=0925$

$$
12 \text { noon }=1200
$$

2.15 in the afternoon $=2.15$ p. $\mathrm{m}=1415$
ten to six in the evening $=5.50$ p. $\mathrm{m}=1750$

$$
12 \text { midnight }=0000 \text { or } 2400
$$
